

DPRK Succeeds in Nuclear Warhead Explosion Test

The Nuclear Weapons Institute of the DPRK made public the following statement Friday:

Scientists and technicians of the DPRK carried out a nuclear explosion test for the judgment of the power of a nuclear warhead newly studied and manufactured by them at the northern nuclear test ground under the plan of the Workers' Party of Korea (WPK) for building strategic nuclear force.

The Central Committee of the WPK sent warm congratulations to nuclear scientists and technicians of the northern nuclear test ground on the successful nuclear warhead explosion test.

The nuclear test finally examined and confirmed the structure and specific features of movement of nuclear warhead that has been standardized to be able to be mounted on strategic ballistic rockets of the Hwasong artillery units of the Strategic Force of the Korean People's Army as well as its performance and power.

It was confirmed through the results of analysis of the test that the measured values including explosive power and the nuclear material usage coefficient conformed with the calculated values and that there was no radioactive materials leakage during the test and, therefore, no adverse impact on the ecological environment of the surroundings.

The standardization of the nuclear warhead will enable the DPRK to produce as many as it requires a variety of smaller, lighter and diversified nuclear warheads of higher strike power with a firm hold on the technology for producing and using various fissile materials. This has definitely put on a higher level the DPRK's technology of mounting nuclear warheads on ballistic rockets.

The nuclear warhead explosion test is a demonstration of the toughest will of the WPK and the Korean people to get themselves always ready to retaliate against the enemies if they make provocation as it is part of practical countermeasures to the racket of threat and sanctions against the DPRK kicked up by the U.S.-led hostile forces who have gone desperate in their moves to find fault with the sovereign state's exercise of the right to self-defence while

DPRK Foreign Ministry Spokesman Refutes Obama's

"Statement" against Nuclear Warheads Explosive Test

A spokesman for the Foreign Ministry of the DPRK issued the following statement on Sunday:

Scientists and technicians of the Nuclear Weapons Institute of the DPRK successfully conducted a nuclear explosive test for judging the power of nuclear warheads. Much upset by this, the Obama group has gone foolish in its moves to incite an atmosphere of putting pressure and stifling the DPRK and to cover up its failed DPRK policy by branding the DPRK as the "harasser of peace".

On Friday Obama personally made public a "statement" in which he branded the DPRK's nuclear warheads explosive test as a "threat" and "provocation" to peace and security and "ignorance" of the international norms of practices, adding that he will never acknowledge the DPRK as a nuclear weapons state but will cooperate with the international community to take additional crucial measures.

The nuclear warheads explosive test was a demonstration of the toughest will of the DPRK that showed it is ready to counterattack the enemies if they make a provocation as it was part of the substantial countermeasures to the

threat of a nuclear war and sanctions racket kicked up by the hostile forces including the U.S.

We are holding fast to the line of simultaneously developing the two fronts to safeguard the sovereignty, right to existence and peace from the ever-increasing nuclear threat and blackmail of the U.S., and the recent test was just part of the whole course of implementing the line.

With the end of its tenure nearing the Obama group has faced a flurry of censures from the public at home and abroad for its totally bankrupt DPRK policy which only resulted in compelling the DPRK to increase its nuclear attack capabilities moment by moment.

Obama's recent publication of the "statement" is aimed to shift the blame for pushing the DPRK to have access to nukes and save even a bit his face that was completely lost before the world.

The U.S. is the very one which compelled the DPRK to develop nuclear warheads, and its nuclear threat and blackmail that have constantly been posed to the DPRK almost every day for the past decades have been an engine which pushed the DPRK to reach this point.

Obama is trying hard to deny the DPRK's strategic position as a legitimate nuclear weapons state but it is as foolish an act as trying to eclipse the sun with a palm.

U.S. Call for "Building of World without Nuclear Weapons" Is Deceptive: KCNA Commentary

The U.S. announced its plan to deploy in earnest B61-12, new-type nuclear bomb, from 2020 and is trying to spend huge additional military expenditure.

The National Security Council approved the production of B61-12 in early August and the engineering preparations for its production have already started in the mainland.

It is said that the bomb would be replaced with B61-3, 4, 7 and 10, tactical nuclear bombs possessed by the U.S. forces, as it is charged with guidance system.

Its bombing test was staged at the nuclear test ground in Nevada State in December 2015.

This is a clear indication of the falsity of the Obama government's "building of world without nuclear weapons."

The U.S. is the chieftain of aggression and war as it produced nuclear weapons for the first time in the world and has fattened the munitions monopolies by sparking off fresh nuclear arms race through modernization of nuclear weapons under the pretext of "world without nuclear weapons." It is the harasser of peace and cesspool of all evils threatening the future of mankind.

In the early period of his office Obama was awarded Nobel Peace Prize for his proposal for the "world without nuclear weapons" but the U.S. ceaseless modernization of nuclear weapons and nuclear blackmail pose greater threat to global peace and security now when the tenure of his office is to expire before long.

The nuclear issue spawned in the international arena and its complicated entanglement is attributable to the U.S. anachronistic nuclear strategy.

The U.S., regarding nukes as an important means of carrying out its strategy for dominating the world, is seeking a way out of overproduction, preservation and maintenance of the stockpiled nuclear warheads and pressure on the

reduction of the defense budget caused by the nuclear arms race in the Cold War period in increasing the quality of nuclear force.

It is the U.S. intention not only to improve its image by hyping the "theory of nuclear disarmament" in the course of removing outdated nuclear weapons and relevant facilities and developing new and modernized ones but also to realize its ambition for nuclear supremacy.

To this end, the U.S. poured the largest-ever funds after the 1950s into the modernization of nuclear weapons in recent years and announced the plan to invest one trillion dollars in it in three decades to come.

The U.S. invariable strategy for nuclear monopoly is fostering nuclear arms race worldwide and compelling other nuclear weapons states to harden their nuclear position.

The DPRK and other countries exposed to the direct nuclear blackmail and threat from the U.S. urgently feel the necessity of bolstering nuclear force.

The U.S. is chiefly to blame for worldwide nuclear proliferation and arms race as it pushes ahead with the modernization of nuclear weapons and plunges the world into nuclear nightmare.

The world would no longer be deceived by the U.S. paradox about the "world without nuclear weapons."
